US-Japan Program on Healthy and Resilient Aging 2023 Program Roundtable Session with University of Tokyo Institute of Gerontology



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■概要：

This session aims to have both the members of University of Tokyo's Institute of Gerontology and JCIE's delegation from Columbus Ohio share their knowledge and expertise. While the roundtable will feature presentations from both sides, the focus should be on building toward an organic discussion that will promote mutual learning. Some questions that the roundtable is intended to address include:

1. What is the role of academic institutions such as the Institute of Gerontology and the Age-Friendly Innovation Center in promoting healthy aging in the community and how can this best be achieved?
2. What is the value of frameworks such as the WHO's 8 domains of age-friendly communities or the Institute of Gerontology's eight pillars in accomplishing their goals? What elements might be missing from either or both frameworks that can be highlighted through this discussion?
3. What are some specific programs taking place in Ohio or Tokyo that have the potential to improve the work being carried out in either location. Some examples might include the University of Tokyo's focus on frailty prevention or Ohio State University's age-friendly scholars program.
